- ! Both the applicant and the applicant's employer or supervisor, if applicable, must sign the application.

Selection Criteria

- ! Applicants are individuals living and/or working within the City of Dryden and immediate surrounding area. Leadership Dryden District endeavors to ensure that the programme reflects the diversity of the community.
- ! Community involvement and work experience will be considered equivalent to academic achievements. The program seeks representation from a cross-section of the community including business, labour, government, education, the arts, community-based organizations, human services and ethnic and minority groups.
- ! Applicants must be able to fulfill program attendance requirements including mandatory attendance at each issue day and both the Opening and Closing retreat. Participants are expected to attend each full day monthly session from January through to June. Participants who are absent for more than 2 issue days will not graduate. No exceptions.
- ! Potential participants will demonstrate:
 - Motivation, leadership potential, community involvement and creativity
 - Commitment to serve the Dryden community following graduation
 - Willingness to make the time commitment required by the program.

NOTE: Class size is limited. Applicants are encouraged to re-apply if not selected.
